Required Publishing Tasks for Conference Publishers

SUBMISSIONS REQUIRED

- Collect copyright transfer agreements, one form per paper, not per author. **IMPORTANT:** The IEEE Copyright Form must be completed.
- Instruct your authors to add the copyright notice to their papers before creating PDFs. Copyright notice can be found in Section IV - Copyright Information in the Letter of Acquisition.
- Instruct your authors to use the IEEE PDF eXpress site to validate their papers (see following page).
- **Provide IEEE Xplore®-compatible PDFs to Conference Operations.**
IMPORTANT: Any changes made to a PDF after IEEE PDF eXpress conversion or PDF Checking may invalidate Xplore compatibility. This includes headers, page numbers, copyright notice, watermarks, etc. If any of these elements are desired, they should be added to the document before a PDF is created.

PDF Instructions for Authors

Before Creating a PDF

Submit copyright transfer agreements, one form per paper, not per author.

The IEEE Copyright Form must be completed and signed.

- Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If necessary, contact Wanus Srimaharaj at wanus_s@payap.ac.th for the appropriate copyright notice.
- For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is: **979-8-3503-1824-1/24/\$31.00 ©2024 Crown**
- For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is **979-8-3503-1824-1/24/\$31.00 ©2024 European Union**
- For all other papers the copyright notice is: **979-8-3503-1824-1/24/\$31.00 ©2024 IEEE**
- Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.

Required Publishing Tasks for Conference Publishers

1. If IEEE is the copyright holder, all authors, which intend on publishing in the IEEE Xplore Digital Library are required to provide a transfer of copyright. IEEE Meetings, Conferences & Events (MCE) will reach out to you with next steps on the Copyright transfer process.
2. Instruct your authors to add the copyright notice to their papers **before** creating PDFs. Copyright notice can be found in Section IV - Copyright Information in the Letter of Acquisition.
3. Instruct your authors to use the IEEE PDF eXpress site to validate their papers (see following page).
4. **Provide IEEE Xplore®-compatible PDFs to IEEE Meetings, Conferences & Events (MCE).**
